  - Reported that 15 High Street pub application rejected by Scottish Government Reporter gov rept, on grounds it could be refurbished as a house which would be in keeping with the residential character of the area. Resident points out by implication that UoA should now refurbish the building as a house.

  - Restoration of Don St / Cheyne Rd "Island Garden" – dealt with under Matters Arising
  - Funding application to develop Local Plan for Old Aberdeen – to be submitted this week
  - Resident reported missing bench on St Machar Drive – Council have been asked to restore it
  - Letter received from Aberdeen Cycle Forum regarding option of a segregated bike path on King St – acknowledged though some concerns raised about whether space for cycle lane would be taken from the pavement

- Removal of illicit gate off Kings Crescent (Cllr. Hutchison): owner has not removed posts, which could still be chained to obstruct access
  - College Bounds bus gate – ineffective traffic control (Cllrs. Grant / McLellan): going to statutory consultation on replacing traffic light with Bedford Road-style bus gate, including proposal for contraflow cycling on Elphinstone Road and Meston Walk
